We have received a number of messages related to the world CLC day.

Amongst other work with the poor, CLC- Lubumbashi has taken on the responsibility of:

Apostolate 1; School Girls.

This apostolate consists of helping girls who have financial difficulties to pay for their studies due to the financial problems their families are facing.

For the last three years CLC has paid for the education the school fees of a few girls. It is planned that the number of girls it will help will be increased in the next few years. It is with these 10 girls that CLC celebrated world CLC day Saturday 20/03/2010.

Apostolate 2; Help for Prisoners

This apostolate, which functions in collaboration with other communities and associations, consists of helping prisoners in the following ways:

Food supply: The prisoners are provided with food.

Legal help: Some CLC members who are lawyers have provided free services for prisoners who cannot afford to buy legal services.

It is not possible to provide photos of this apostolate as taking pictures inside the prison is strictly forbidden.

Medical help: In collaboration with other communities and associations the community provides medicine to prisoners in need of primary care.

Apostolate 3; Help for the sick

The membership fees, and other regular donations are used to provide aid to hospitalized persons who are residents in the suburbs of Lubumbashi. These funds are used in the following ways:

Food aid: The inmates of the hospital are provided with some food.

Medical aid: CLC pays for the cost of the medication, of persons suffering from particular illnesses, during their hospital stay.
